MARCH 23 SERMON TOPIC: Abram

Sermon scripture: Genesis 12:1-4a

OUT OF THE PULPITFrom Pastor Jim Coston

Our time in the wilderness will soon come to an end, I hope. The Elders will discern a path and make a decision. The congregation will then decide whether or not to follow that path. Then we travel. While we have had an arduous journey, the benefits are not just at the end of the road; God has blessed us as we have traveled.

There is an analogy between ocean cruises and a church. On a cruise, you have crew and passengers. Passengers are temporary, there to be served, partakers not contributors. Crew do the work. You can think of church participants in the same way. There are passengers who attend for themselves, their enjoyment, their passage. And there are crew who do the work. Crew is not simply church staff of course but anyone who attends to serve—serve Jesus, serve other members, serve outsiders.

At this point in the life of FBCScottsdale, we have very few passengers. Everyone is aware of the need for all to do the work. The direction of the church is everyone's responsibility. The mission of the church is everyone's responsibility. The health of the church is everyone's responsibility. Not the responsibility of others or of staff or of Elders, but of everyone. We didn't have that mentality six months ago; I believe we have it now. For that, I give thanks. This is a mentality we will need to exact God's mission for FBCScottsdale.

RESULTS OF VOTE BY CONGREGATION Sunday, March 16

The congregation voted to move the Annual Meeting from the end of March, per our Bylaws, to April 27, 2025, and to extend the terms of expiring Elders until the same date (Dean Duncan, Cheryl Martinet, and James Olsen).

Why the extension? The North Parking Lot is under contract and should close the week of April 27. This sale, or non-sale if the deal falls through, affects our Fiscal Year 2025-2026 budget. The delay will provide clarity as the Elders bring new Elder nominees and a new budget for approval, one reflecting the eventuality of the North Parking Lot contract.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE OF FBCScottsdale

The Elders are prayerfully considering options for the long-term continuation of God's ministry at 70th Street and Osborn. One option comes from the 5-Year Revitalization Plan Team. The other comes from Christ Church of the Valley.

We will update you when there is more information to share.

Please keep the Elders and your church in prayer as we seek to follow Jesus wherever he leads.


