# SERMON TOPIC FOR DECEMBER 14: 1 JOHN

#### SCRIPTURE READING:

1 John 3:1-3 Luke 2:8-14 John 15:9-11



On Wednesday, December 17, 6:30pm, FBCScottsdale will hold a Blue Christmas worship service in the Sanctuary.

Our society has built up Christmas into an unrealistic caricature of what happened in Bethlehem over 2000 years ago. We typically associate Christmas with family gatherings and gifts and happiness flowing all over the place. As we are broken, so are our families—there are loved ones who have departed; many families contain broken relationships; and frankly some families do not provide safe space. Shopping is an empty pursuit, often

filled with more frustration than satisfaction. And the world does not take a break from conflict (physical or verbal) for this month.

If we read through the gospel nativities closely, we witness a world in strife. Jewish citizens had to return to their hometowns to be counted so that an Emperor half a world away could stroke his ego with that number. More localized, the Gospel presents a pregnant unmarried teen. A fiancé watches his betrothed grow more visible with child every day, knowing that the child is not his. And when the birth comes, they lack basic shelter and family support. No shopping, no family, and no peace.

Christmas gives us a glimpse of real life—messy, hard, difficult real life. We will embrace the truth of the nativity and the reality of our own lives on Wednesday, December 17, 6:30p in the Sanctuary.


Invite others who need to hear this message as we find comfort and solace in the birth of Jesus Christ!

Regardless of whether you are an avid poker player or someone who just enjoys casually playing cards, this is a night of fellowship and fun.




#### THE UNSTUCK CHURCH

Sunday, December 14 9:15-10:15a In Winfield's (not Fellowship Hall)


