### NONAVAILABILITY OF C-2 (FIRESIDE ROOM)

Over the past few years, Staff and the Elders have tried to maximize our campus to help pay the bills of ministry. We share our property often and with many. The construction company that will turn the Olive Garden property into an assisted living residence contacted us in late 2023 about using a portion of the south parking lot for storage of their equipment. We have provided this before so no big deal. Then, they asked if they could utilize space on our campus to serve as their office for the 22 months of construction. The Elders voted last year to allow the construction company to take up residence in the Fireside Room, C-2, during construction.

Here we are in May 2025, and the construction company is ready to take up residence in C-2 and begin working on new neighbors for us. So, **as of Monday, May 19**, we won't be using C-2. It means several groups will relocate from the Fireside Room to another area on campus. It means we will have some guests who we will get to know and to whom we will offer hospitality.


Staff and the Elders view this both as a gift from our Lord and a sacrifice of our congregation. Keep this in prayer please.

Here are the exciting choices. We pray you will choose one to attend:





## THE GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE In E-2 (Behind Winfield's)



### CHANENI HOUSE REPORT - EMPTY SHELVES!





About 120 people came to Chaneni House in four days last week. Then on Monday we were off to another record-breaking week with 36 clients coming. We praise God that we were able to help. Of course, that means we now need donations of everything—all clothing, household items, toys, and groceries. Still most critical is the shortage of men's underwear and socks as well as toys.

#### Do we have anybody who still sews?

Volunteers make cloth bags for the hygiene items for the homeless. For the first time we are sending out a request for cloth. Do you have remnants? We need a piece about 12x20 inches for each bag.

Keeping the grocery bags filled is another ongoing task. If you can pick up an item or two when you shop, items that are problems include boxed cereal, 16 oz. peanut butter, and 15 oz. canned fruit. Any monetary donations designated for Chaneni House are used for groceries or for repairs such as the door we are currently needing to replace.

Thank you for all our wonderful donors and for all our hardworking volunteers—you make this ministry possible.
