A VISIT FROM DAVID AND JOYCE REED



We were honored on Sunday to have David and Joyce Reed speak to us about their work with International Ministries, and challenge us with the question – **“who are you called to walk beside?”**

David and Joyce serve as global coordinators for spiritual care for International Ministries. Building on twenty years of ministry in Mexico and service as regional consultants in Iberoamerica and the Caribbean, David and Joyce seek to cultivate a culture of health in which IM global personnel and home office staff can thrive and be effective in ministry.



They offer spiritual guidance, support and presence, and mentor global servants during their first year of service. The Reeds walk with colleagues through significant times of transition and transformation, including grief and loss. Additionally, they provide credible resources to support spiritual growth and health, offering workshops and retreats on self-care, soul care and community care practice.

David first felt his calling to serve God right here at FBCScottsdale. Joyce is the inspiration for our Women’s Ministry’s Joyce Reed Mission Circle. The JRMC meets once a month to perform service projects and support the Reeds and our other missionaries serving abroad, including Mark Zeeman in Hungary, Matt & Lori Mann in Southeast Asia, and Trenton & Hailey Slagle in France.
